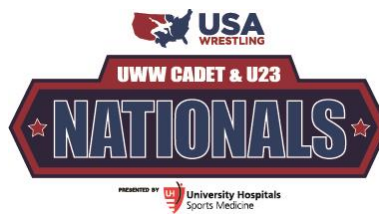
### Strider Cup

### **September 7th-9th - Edgewater Park**

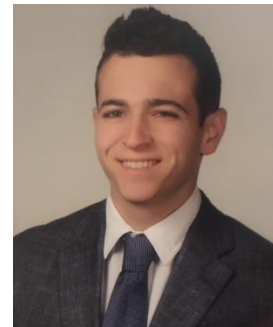
It's that time of the year again....NEOCycle 2018 is only a few months away! We will be recruiting volunteers for the event this September 7th-9th in the following roles:

On May 4th, GCSC Staff members and Associate Board built 190 bikes as part of the Earn-A-Bike program with [Youth Education through Sports](#) presented by [University Hospitals Rainbow Babies & Children's Hospital](#) and [The Sherwin-Williams Company](#).

In order to earn a bicycle, children from City of Cleveland recreation centers will be invited to attend an educational Field Day in June and complete a series of lessons and activities. The top 150 scorers in the program will receive a newly-assembled bicycle, helmet, lock and lessons in bicycle education and safety.
