Thank you to everyone who dedicated their time and energy in making NEOCycle a success. We had 2,189 cyclists join us from 16 states (and Canada).

Our Volunteer Team was instrumental in helping to run several aspects of the event, including: Registration and Packet Pick-Up, the Night Ride, Cyclocross, Velodrome, and Fundo competitions.

We had 107 volunteers commit to 130 shifts for a total of 548.5 hours. Great job, team!

YES Programming 2018 Earn-a-Bike

In conjunction with NEOCycle, GCSC recently completed our fifth summer of the Earna-Bike program by giving away **145 new bikes, helmets, locks, and safety instructions** **to City of Cleveland youth**. This program is part of Youth Education through Sports (YES) presented by University Hospitals Rainbow Babies & Children's Hospital and The Sherwin-Williams Company.

Over 200 children from the City of Cleveland Recreation Centers completed an "energy" themed Field Day at the beginning of June. Attendees participated in activities covering topics such as nutrition, physical activity, energy and bikes, yoga and meditation, and the importance of positive sportsmanship.

Youth received a workbook following the event to test their knowledge and to track their progress in a variety of concepts covered that day. The top scorers of the program came back in July to receive their bikes, helmets, locks, and lessons in bicycle safety.
