

Pickle in the Land Ticket Raffle

Please read these Official Rules before entering the Pickle in the Land Ticket Raffle (the "Raffle"). By purchasing an entry into Pickle in the Land, you represent that you meet all of the below-stated requirements and agree to be bound by these Official Rules, and by the decisions of Greater Cleveland Sports Commission, (the "Sponsor"), a 501(c)(3) charitable organization, or its representative.

Cavs - Two (2) tickets with all-inclusive Caesars Rewards Club access for 10/28 vs Wizards

Monsters – Two (2) tickets with all-inclusive Caesars Rewards Club access to a mutually agreed upon game

Charge – Two (2) floor seats with all-inclusive Club access to a mutually agreed upon game

1. Prize(s). The prize(s) that may be awarded to the eligible winner(s) are not transferable, redeemable for cash or exchangeable for any other prize. All prizes must be redeemed within 30 days of the Raffle end date unless otherwise stated in these Official Rules. If a winner cannot be contacted or is disqualified for any reason, the Sponsor reserves the right to determine an alternate winner or not to award that winner's prize, in its sole discretion.

2. Eligibility and Limitations. Participants and winner(s) must be U.S. residents. The Raffle is only open to anyone eighteen (18) years of age and older as of the date of purchase. Only one winner per entry is allowed. Need not be present to win. Employees of the Sponsor are not eligible to participate and win. VOID IN ANY JURISDICTION WHERE PARTICIPATION IS PROHIBITED.

All federal, state, and local laws and regulations apply. By entering the Raffle, you represent and warrant to Sponsor that you meet these criteria. You further represent and warrant that your participation in or attempted participation in the Raffle does not violate any federal, state, or local law or regulation that governs your entry into the Raffle. By participating in the Raffle, you unconditionally accept and agree to comply with and abide by these Rules and Regulations and Sponsor's interpretation of and decisions under these Official Rules, which will be final and binding in all respects.

3. Entry. You may enter the Raffle, if you meet the eligibility requirements, by agreeing to follow these Official Rules and purchasing an entry into Pickle in the Land. All Raffle ticket entries must be completed by the end of the applicable Raffle Period. The Sponsor is not liable for any lost, later, misdirected, incomplete, illegible, undelivered, or destroyed tickets regardless of cause or person responsible including, but not limited to, any problem or technical malfunction of any computer, online system or server or technical problem.

4. Drawing. The prize winner will be selected in a random drawing from among all eligible Raffle entries during the Raffle period. The Raffle period is stated as anyone who registers for the Pickle in the Land event by September 21, 2027 is entered into the Raffle drawing.

5. How to Claim a Prize. The winner of the raffle will be notified by email within 24 hours of the Raffle period closure. To claim the prize, the winner of the Raffle (a "Prize Claimant") must contact Sponsor and present the email in person to 334 Euclid Avenue, Cleveland, Ohio 44114, or they can contact a Greater Cleveland Sports Commission Representative by calling 216-363-1107 within thirty (30) days of the drawing. The Raffle email is the only valid receipt for claiming a prize and must be redeemed either in person or via mail. Each Prize Claimant must provide Sponsor with all information required to claim a prize (including tax identification information). The Prize Claimant will receive instructions on how to redeem their Prize.

In the event a Prize Claimant: (a) does not notify Sponsor within thirty (30) days of drawing; (b) is ruled ineligible for any reason; (c) refuses the prize; or (d) does not return an executed Affidavit within thirty

(30) days, the Prize will be forfeited and will be retained by Sponsor. Sponsor has no obligation to contact potential winners. All prizes will be delivered transferred via email prior to the first game of the Prize, provided that winner has delivered the winning Raffle email, executed Affidavit, and all other required documents to Sponsor. In the event of unclaimed winnings, Sponsor reserves the right to determine an alternate winner or not to award that winner's prize, in its sole discretion.

6. PR, Publicity, Promotion; Use of Personal Information. By participating in the Raffle, where allowed by law, all participants and winner(s) grant the Sponsor Parties (as defined below) exclusive permission to use their names, characters, photographs, voices, and likenesses in connection with promotion of this and other Raffles and waive any claims to royalty, right, or remuneration for such use. By participating in the Raffle, where allowed by law, participants agree that the Sponsor Parties may disclose personal information obtained from participants in the Raffle to third parties and use such information for marketing and other purposes.

7. Release. By participating in the Raffle, each participant and winner waives any and all claims of liability against the Sponsor, Rock Entertainment Group LLC, Cavaliers Holdings, LLC, each of their respective affiliates and their respective employees and agents, the Raffle's sponsors and their respective employees and agents (collectively, the "Sponsor Parties"), for any personal injury or loss which may occur from the conduct of, or participation in, the Raffle, or from the use of any prize.

9. Conduct, Judging, and Decisions. By participating in the Raffle, participants agree to be bound by the decisions of Sponsor personnel. Persons who violate any rule, gain unfair advantage in participating in the Raffle, or obtain winner status using fraudulent means will be disqualified. Unsportsmanlike, disruptive, annoying, harassing or threatening behavior is prohibited. The Sponsor will interpret these rules and resolve any disputes, conflicting claims or ambiguities concerning the rules or the Raffle and the Sponsor's decisions concerning such disputes shall be final. If the conduct or outcome of the Raffle is affected by human error, any mechanical malfunctions or failures of any kind, intentional interference or any event beyond the control of the Sponsor, the Sponsor reserves the right to terminate this Raffle, or make such other decisions regarding the outcome as the Sponsor deems appropriate. All decisions will be made by the Sponsor and are final. The Sponsor may waive any of these rules in its sole discretion.

10. Disputes and Governing Law. The Raffle shall be governed by the laws of the State of Ohio without giving effect to any choice of law or conflict of law rule of any jurisdiction. Any claims regarding the Raffle that are not released, must be brought in the State or Federal Courts in Cuyahoga County, Ohio, and Participant hereby consents to the personal jurisdiction of such courts for purposes of any such action.

The Raffle is void where prohibited by law.
